Established in 2006 by South Kensington Estates, the longest running district of London Design Festival, Brompton Design District has a reputation for iconic brands and progressive design thinking. The district is unique in its close dialogue between established design brands and a temporary curated programme.

In conjunction with the area's landmark cultural institutions, such as the RCA, the Design Museum and the V&A, this unique family of retailers has spearheaded the evolution of Brompton as a leading design destination.

Nurtured by South Kensington Estates, co-founders of Brompton Design District and custodians of Brompton as a whole, the revitalised area has seen the arrival of established and emerging design brands. They include leading Italian furniture brands such as Cassina and Molteni & C and high-end interiors emporia The Conran Shop, Oka, Meridiani and Poltrona Frau.

For London Design Festival 2021, Brompton Italian brands Cassina and Molteni & C. pay homage to two generations of the Scarpa family. Cassina reissues Soriana by Afra & Tobia Scarpa with a contemporary material palette. At Molteni & C. the new collection is a tribute to two great protagonists of Italian architecture Carlo Scarpa and Ignazio Gardella alongside additions to the heritage collection by Gio Ponti. Molteni also present an installation by Jasper Morrison to celebrate the launch of his new Tea Chair.

The Conran Shop has commissioned French artist Damian Poulain to create 'The Magical Value of Shapes', a playful graphic backdrop to the store's exclusive new collections. An exciting mix of 30 Brompton brands and exhibits will open their doors, present new products, and unveil intriguing installations and imaginative exhibitions.

Centre-stage in Brompton's temporary programme curated by Jane Withers Studio, is an exhibition titled New Contracts by MA Design Products at the Royal College of Art. Here, graduates who have spent the majority of their studies away from the physical university, present their work in real life for the first time. Through their graduation projects, they examine their role as designers, challenging the return to 'business as usual' and exploring what the future should look like.

Brompton exhibits will also be hosted in the district's new gallery hub, Cromwell Place. Here Dzek presents New Landscapes for the Post-Normal Domestic, a new collection of tiled furniture modules by Formafantasma using ExCinere, their volcanic ash glazed tile system. While SEEDS Gallery showcases a positive response to the theme with an installation entitled More Joy.

New Adventures in Cardboard by Brown Office, the Thurloe Place Mews, part exhibition and part makerspace, encourages us to revalue cardboard as a versatile material for everyday use.
