

The Conran Shop x Damien Poulain

This London Design Festival, The Conran Shop will celebrate the launch of its most coveted, exclusive pieces of the year with an enthralling and innovative window installation by French artist Damien Poulain. Poulain will transform the brand's flagship Chelsea store window into a graphically led three-dimensional canvas of colourful geometric shapes that invite the viewer to explore the exclusive product offering, as well as the space itself, from myriad perspectives.

Poulain has utilised the existing large steel grid structure in the window as a canvas for his larger-than-life artwork, seeking inspiration from the colour and forms found in the building and natural environment. With the clever use of vividly coloured abstract shapes that run the full height and length of the window, the result will be a fitting backdrop to the brand's latest additions.



About Damien Poulain

Poulain's practice uses Shintoist, primitive, and heraldic symbology as well as contemporary materials and digital culture to create a distinct visual language. Through an evolving range of formats, including textiles and sculptures, Poulain devises symbolic systems of geometry and colour, raising questions about how humans relate to each other, their surroundings, and the mystery of existence. Poulain's work has been exhibited, amongst others, at London's Kemistry Gallery, Tokyo's 21_21 Design Sight Museum and Breda's Museum of Graphic Design.



Poulain on the inspiration behind the collaboration

"The three-dimensional aspect of the shelves allowed me to create a painting with depth. From the front, it is considered a painting representing modular faces created with simple geometrical shapes, yet, from a different angle, we start to get inside the painting and discover new patterns. I want the viewer to project themselves into the art, see things appearing in their mind and create their own colourful vision. We do not see the world as it is, but as we want to see it."



Poulain on the collaboration with The Conran Shop

"I always try to push myself to express my thoughts and emotions freely, without the constraints of how others should see me. My work is informed by everything surrounding me, including architectural details, which clarifies my partnering with The Conran Shop. My work is difficult to frame and tends to crossover disciplines, and The Conran Shop is one of those rare clients that commission artists and allow them to express their creativity without any constraints."

"Our Chelsea store has a huge display window that works very well when seen directly face on, or when viewed from left to right or vice versa. We currently have a large steel grid structure that displays sixty iconic chairs, and briefed Damien to use it freshly and imaginatively. The result: a two-dimensional design rendered in three dimensions which changes based on the angle of approach. In essence, it will work as an eye-catching backdrop to our new and exclusive product launches in September."



Exclusive PP225 Flag Halyard Lounge Chair by Hans J. Wegner for PP Møbler, £9,185

A tribute to the early modernists, the PP225 Flag Halyard Lounge Chair was conceived by Hans J. Wegner whilst on a beach holiday with his family. Digging into the sand to create a comfortable shape to recline in, the angled wing shape for the lounge chair was created, now clothed in a global-exclusive salesco olive-lacquered frame, agnellohued bouclé alpaca wool cushion from dedar, and chestnut bridle leather straps.
